Essential Criteria	
We are based in the North York Moors National Park or the wider influence area* and will promote/support Walking tourism activities and events via our website, literature, emails, social media and face to face.	
As part of the North York Moors Tourism Network I will make people aware of and promote other Walking Friendly network businesses wherever possible/appropriate i.e. accommodation providers (if appropriate)	
We are located on or close to walking routes in the North York Moors and surrounding areas.	
We allow muddy boots and wet bums in our premises and if necessary provide boot covers and specific seating.	
We provide reference information such outdoor OS maps, printed walking routes, local walking guide books and information during events or organised walks	
We provide links on our website or in our premises (with WiFi access) to online walks, websites, apps and places to enjoy Walking across the North York Moors	
We offer a water bottle fill up service. You may wish to sign up to initiative like www.refill.org	
We support and promote sustainable and responsible walking including promoting the Countryside Code and North York Moors 'Moors Message'.	
We provide access to an outdoor first aid kit.	
You may also wish to consider:	
Offering tea coffee flask fill up service (chargeable)	
We provide take away products like cake/flapjack in environmentally friendly packaging (chargeable)	
We provide free printed paper maps such as walks from the North York Moors website to take away.
